

Purpose

The Purpose of this agreement is to promote a collaborative bond between these institutions that leads to cooperation in the Academic field of education, skill development and research.



Scope of the MoU

This agreement will focus on enhanced collaboration and interaction between the First Party and the Second Party in areas related to

- Joint research projects and publications, including work by undergraduate, graduate,
 and post-doctoral students at the partner institutions;
- Dual degree programs;
- Faculty and student exchanges based on reciprocity;
- Reciprocal placement of students in paid internships and co-ops, when possible;
- Joint conferences and workshops;
- Team taught courses, including online courses; and Visits by faculty, professional staff, and students.

i. Co-operation in Faculty Exchange for Coaching Classes and Training Programs:

Faculty exchange programs involve sharing academic staff between institutions. In the context of coaching classes and training programs, this could mean that faculty members from one institution teach or provide training at another institution, and vice versa. This exchange helps in sharing expertise and promoting a diverse learning environment.

ii. Assistance in Certificate Courses as Subject Experts and BoS (Board of Studies)

Subject experts often play a crucial role in designing and delivering certificate courses. They provide their specialized knowledge and insights to ensure the curriculum is relevant and up-to-date. A "Board of Studies" typically refers to a group responsible for shaping the curriculum and educational policies of an institution or program. So, this point suggests collaboration in developing and maintaining certificate courses with the help of subject experts and advisory boards.

iii. Student and Faculty Development Programs

Student and faculty development programs aim to enhance the skills, knowledge, and overall growth of both students and teachers. These programs can encompass



various aspects, including workshops, training sessions, mentorship, and resources to help individuals reach their full potential in an academic setting.

Workshops and Seminars iv.

Workshops and seminars are often organized to provide additional learning opportunities beyond regular coursework. They can focus on specific topics, skills, or areas of interest. Collaborating on workshops and seminars can help institutions share resources, expertise, and offer a broader range of educational experiences to students and faculty.

These points indicate a desire for collaboration and partnership between educational institutions, which can lead to a more comprehensive and enriched educational experience for all involved.

Duration

The MoU shall be effective from 16-07-2022 to 15-07-2025. This MoU may be modified or extended by mutual written agreement of the two parties. This MoU may be terminated by either party upon six months of advance written notice.
