NSS Report - 2013-14

We have two NSS units no. 33 & 46 that have around two hundred volunteers. Mr. Sabu O J and Ms. Lisha A are the program officers. The units have undertaken a number of programs that help the students to have a socially committed attitude in their education. The volunteers are trained to preserve human values in their life along with the honours and titles that they achieve in their academic tenure. To accomplish this NSS organizes the following activities.

Organized two orientation programs and two personality development programs for the volunteers. Orientation programs were conducted on 13th and 20th July 2013. Mr. Regi Francis Lecturer of our college and Mr. James Paul of St Catherine's HSS Payyampally were the resource persons. Personality development programs were conducted on 4th and 11th August 2013. Resource persons were Mr. Jocymon Joseph and Mr. Thomas Kallarakal. Volunteers actively participated and benefited from the seminars.

Observed the reading day on 28th June 2013 and conducted a quiz contest for the entire students of the campus. The students from the English department are the winners.

Visited one orphanage. Visited Karuna Bhavan, Kartikulam, an old age home, on 3rd July 2012. Around 70 volunteers were there in the team. They interacted with the inmates, prepared food for them, cleaned the surroundings and washed their clothes etc.

Observed Hiroshima-Nagasaki Day on 6th August and organized a poetry writing competition for the students on 'Horrors of War'. The students took anti-war oath.

Celebrated the Independence Day with the patients of Gov. District Hospital Mananthavady by distributing 'payasam' to the patients and bi-standers. The fund was collected from the staff and students of the college. Also organized patriotic song competition on 14th August for the students of the college in department wise.

One day palliative care orientation program was organized for the students on 15th September. 50 volunteers participated.

NSS program officers attended program officer's meeting at University campus. Program officer Mr Sabu O J attended 7days orientation course at Training and Orientation Centre, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences, Kalamassey.

Observed NSS day on 24th September 2012 by distributing message cards and sweets within the campus.

Organized a two-day pre-camp 'Orukkam' for the volunteers on 17th and 18th October 2013 in the campus. Seminars, training programs, workshops were the major events in the Camp.

Observed AIDS day on 1st December 2012 and exhibited posters on the notice board.

Special camp 'Spandanam' for NSS volunteers was conducted from 20th December 2013 to 26th December 2012 at Sarvodayam HSS Eachome. 100 volunteers attended the camp. Constructing a home for a homeless person was the major event of the camp. Construction of the work is expected to be completed by the end of April 2014.

Conducted two nature study one day trips for the volunteers.

NSS has taken the responsibility of preserving the campus green. It has planted around 250 saplings in and around the campus and protects them. It also extends support to maintain college garden.

One hour tuition class for tribal students is handled by the volunteers in evening in nearby colony.

Regularly do the poster exhibitions in its Notice board which deals with the current issues and problems of the society.

Actively participating in campus cleaning activities along with other clubs and associations in the campus. It also extends strong support to make the campus plastic free.

Apart from these the volunteers extend their support to all the programs conducted within the campus and also in social activities. The principal Dr. Raju George and the team support the NSS activities wholeheartedly.
