The National Cadet Corps:

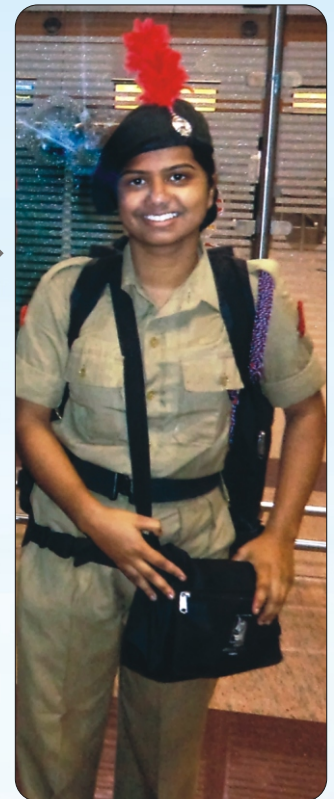
