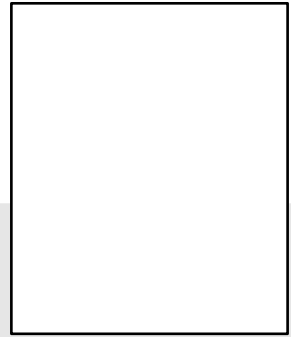

The college offers seven Degree Courses, two PG Courses and Doctoral Programmes in Mathematics and Zoology. The Research Centre in English is awaiting University approval.
