



June - July 2020

College was closed from 10 March 2020 to 31 March 2020, after the outbreak of Covid 19. Regular classes were suspended from 10 March 2020. University examinations and practical Examinations were conducted till 20 March 2020. National Lockdown was announced from 23rd March 2020 to 30th June 2020.

College reopened on 1st June 2020 and the government asked to conduct online classes for the students from 8.30 a.m to 1.30 p.m, Monday to Thursday and 8:00 a.m to 1:00 pm on Fridays.

A one day workshop was conducted on 2nd June 2020 for the office staff on 'Role of Support Staff in Quality Assessment in Higher Education'. The workshop was led by Dr Maria Martin Joseph and the Manager presided over the programme.

College organized one week long Faculty Development Programme on Learning Management System (LMS). It was a hands-on training programme on Moodle online platform for teachers. Training was conducted by Mr Toby Joseph and Dr Maria Martin Joseph. From 1st June to 5th June 2020.

We have started a website for Learning Management System (LMS) for blended learning. The Domain name is <http://marymatha.vlms.net>.

Practical Examinations for Computer science and Chemistry was conducted on 3rd and 5th June for the UG final year students.

College website domain name was activated as www.marymathacollege.ac.in from this academic year 2020-21.

We have enhanced the internet connectivity, by adding on 50 mbps to the already existing connection for taking online classes. Each department is provided with LAN and Wifi.

Our college facilitated and conducted the exams for St Berchmanscollege, Kottayam and St. Thomas College, Thrisur (autonomous colleges) for their students who reside in Wayanad. It was the examination center from 11th to 20th June and on July 10th.

The first phase of the construction of the RUSA -funded college building (intended to house the central library and the auditorium) was done on 29th June 2020 by KIIDC. The construction is going on systematically, despite the constraints of the pandemic situation.

Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) was submitted on 29th June 2020 for the academic year 2019-20.

Kannur University Distance Education Examinations were conducted in the college, as per the instructions of the University, from 6th to 13th July 2020. 261 students were allotted to the college.
