### Report on Network, Office Automation and Website

The committee for Office automation and networking took up three major tasks in this academic year. One was the revamping of the existing network infrastructure, second was the introduction



of office and attendance automation software and the third was the introduction of a new college website.

### 1. Revamping of network infrastructure

As part of this the collective bandwidth was increased to 700 Mbps. All the staff rooms were provided with individual connection with wired and wireless access to the network.Student Wi-Fi access points were installed at different places, ensuring network access for all. Systems in the office and examination rooms were provided with a separate connection.

### 2. Office Automation Software

After considering the difficulties raised by the staff and students on the existing pen and paper procedures, the college decided to reintroduce the TCS (Total Campus Solution) Software for office automation and attendance management. Teaching staff were given training in marking the attendance using the software and administrative staff on office automation. With the introduction of the software and the mobile application, attendance marking was completely automated. Students were given access to the mobile application for viewing the attendance, making the process more transparent. The mobile application was made available in both appstore and playstore for android and ios users.

### 3. New College Website.

A new college website is being developed and is in the final stages. The new website will have a new design and will have more features than the existing website. It is expected to be up and running in the coming days.




### 2. Workshop on wildlife photography
