Internal Mentoring

The internal mentors meet their mentees in groups and personally at certain fixed timings agreed upon by the parties. Gradually, the mentor and mentee establishes warm relationship and rapport. Personal details of all the mentees were collected. It includes economic and social background, family details, previous academic performance, hobbies and extension activities etc. After assessing their backgrounds and plans, guidance is given based on their needs. The internal mentoring session was a support to the mentees to identify their genuine interest. The session for internal mentoring was scheduled by the mentors themselves according to their convenience and engaged at least 15 hours by each of them. The sessions were arranged after the regular class and on Saturdays. Attendance register for the scholars and mentors was maintained separately. All the mentors submitted their internal mentoring report in the prescribed format.

External Mentoring

Many mentees mainly faced problems of emotional imbalance, stage fear, communication skills and lack of confidence. External mentoring sessions were organized in such way that the mentees can overcome these problems. The resource persons selected for the mentoring started their sessions in the third week of January 2017. This was scheduled according to the convenience of the resource persons and all the mentees were allowed to attend the sessions. The interactive sessions focused on solving problems of stage fear, communication and confidence of mentees. Special emphasis was given to motivate and create confidence among mentees to avail better future opportunities.

This tremendous journey of one year with a scholar was really a matter of self revelation. Students were really made to realize the potentials within them. They come forward unhesitatingly to express themselves and explore the world.

As a part of this innovation we have conducted a number of activities. The students meet the internal mentors and share their views, ideas, knowledge etc once in every week. The common meeting of the members are also conducted and is chaired by the coordinator. This is an opportunity to evaluate to share and specially to assess the progress of students.

External Sessions

1. Goal setting

A goal setting workshop was conducted on 21-01-2017 at college auditorium for the first year mentees. Mr Sudheesh Kumar, guided the students. This programme was intended to set goal for the mentees and to assist them of the ways and means to achieve them. It was really interactive and vibrant in nature. The students actively participated in the interactive discussions. This session was really successful in achieving its aim and received good feedback from the mentees. Hence, the session was arranged for the second year mentees on 28.01.2017.

2. Survival tactics

It is not enough to have goals in life, but persons should have the willingness to slog to achieve success. Hence, a sequence to the goal setting session, was lead by Ms Sonia Ratheesh, Head, Training Division, Thiruvananthapuram on 21.01.2017 for the second year mentees. It was a highly interactive and thought provoking workshop for the second year mentees as per the feedbacks from the students. The session was a virtual experience of getting down from our comfort zone and face the realities of life to achieve the goals in life. The same session was held for the first year mentees on 28.01.2017.

3. Three day Residential Workshop

In consultation with the Principal and the College Council, a three day residential workshop was organised in the College for the mentees on February 17-19, 2017. Many external experts

were invited during the workshop to make the external mentoring more effective and meaningful. A formal inaugural function was held in the college auditorium at 4.30 pm in the auditorium. Mr Shabil Krishnan, a documentary director and noted writer was the chief guest. Principal, Manager, Coordinator, internal mentors and mentees attended the function. Later sessions were organized for the mentees. Girls and accompanying lady teachers were accommodated in the Ladies Hostel. Boys and gents teachers stayed at the College.

Dr. Abdul Muneer, Dr. Sarin P, Mr. Binu M C, Ms, Sheela Kannan, Mr. Sudheesh Kumar and Mr. Shibu Kurumbemadam animated the sessions for the students. Post dinner sessions were left to the mentees to organize informal programmes of their own. Leaders emerged from the group and they did a wonderful work in organizing a fun filled time. Yoga sessions in the mornings by Ms Sheela Kannan were refreshing experiences.

The sessions ranged from speech craft, transactional analysis, career opening, media literacy to critical learning skills. The camp turned out to be a big success and students were unanimous in recommending to hold similar programmes frequently under the banner of WWS.






