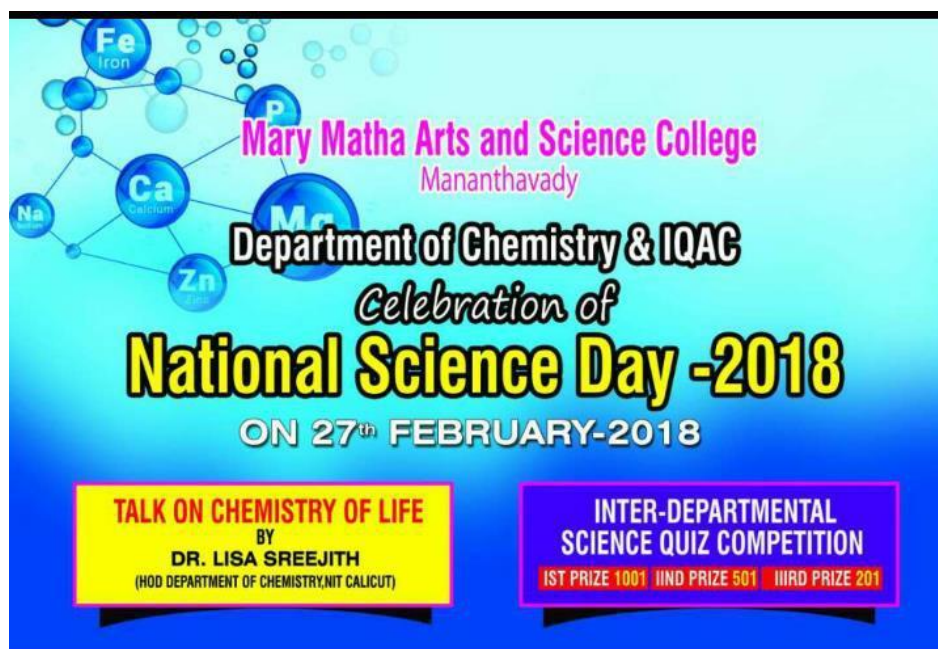

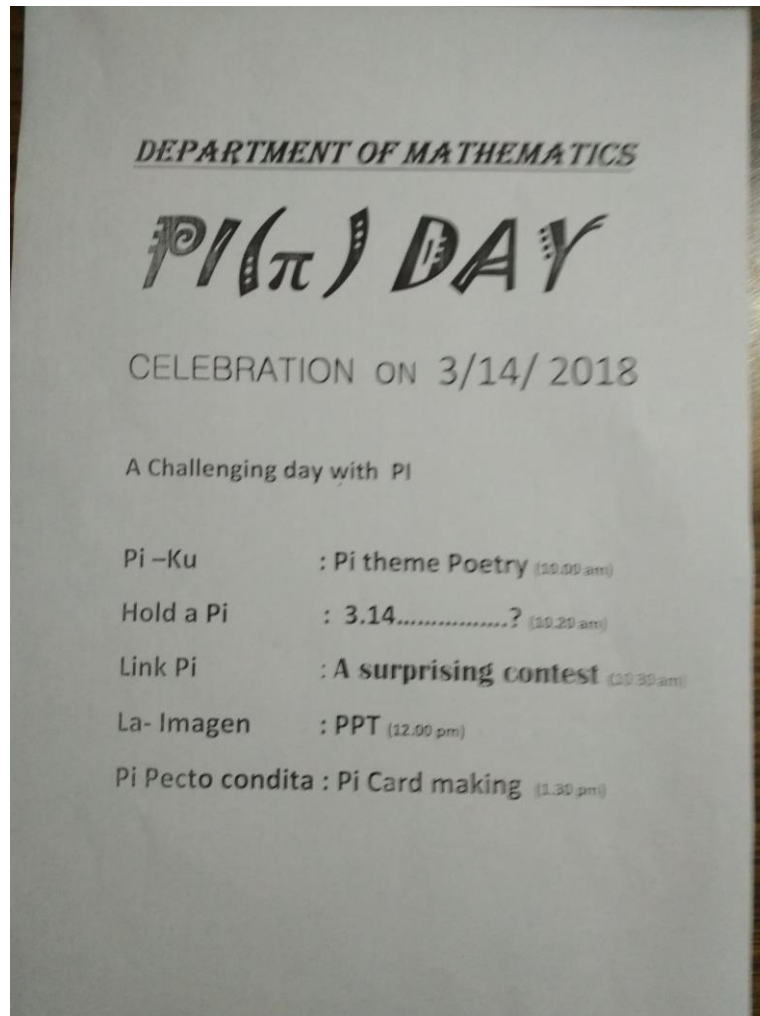
Film Festival 2015

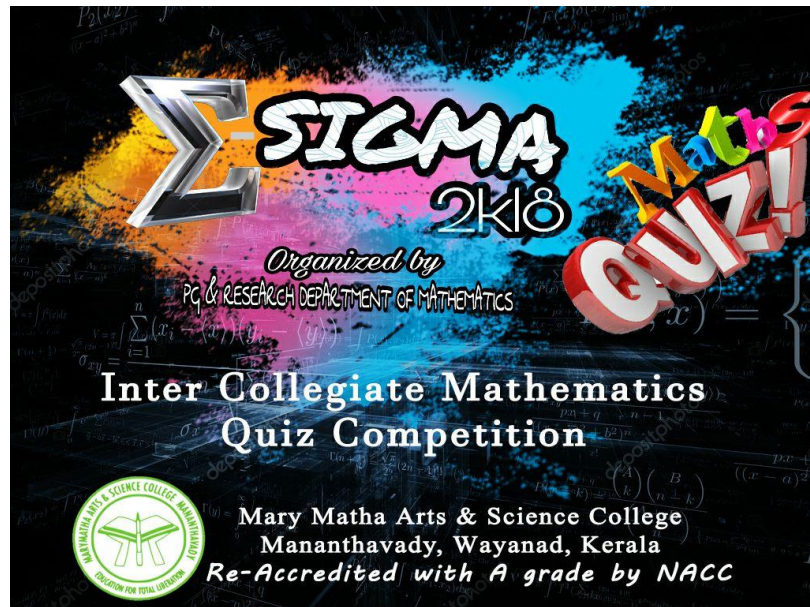

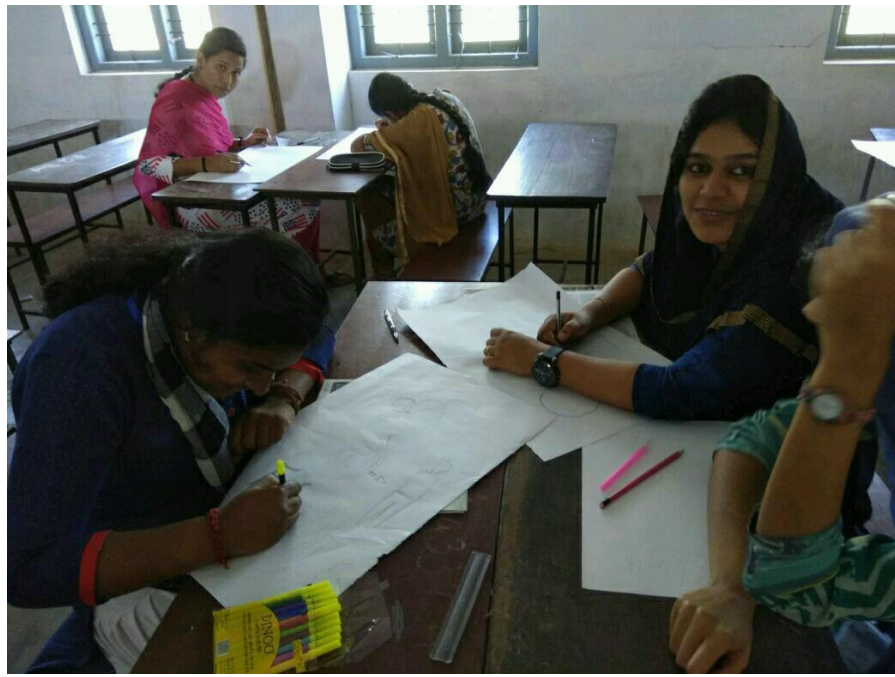
